<b>Open Events</b> [for all classes]	
<b>Software Display</b>	Number of Teams: <b>2</b> Maximum number of participants per team: <b>2</b>  The students are required to bring original software created by them on CD/DVD, along with well-formatted hardcopy of the source code and user manual for the preliminary round. Maximum 6 schools shall be selected for the finals. No compiler will be provided during the event. All teams will be given a preliminary 5 minutes time (excluding time for interjections). Judges and Audience will both be allowed to interject. We will be providing a Standard Windows based machine (without internet), if your software requires a different configuration or requires special add-on software/Hardware/Internet support or more installation time, you are advised to bring your own machine with all add-on support.  If there is any <b>robot/device</b> , which can be operated or controlled by your software, please provide us the detailed mechanical/electronic blueprint of that robot/device.
<b>Group Discussion</b>	Number of Team: <b>1</b> Number of participant per team: <b>1</b> <b>Topic for the Final will be available at <a href="http://www.modernschool.net/access/">www.modernschool.net/access/</a> on 20th December</b>  Participants would be expected to look at the technical, commercial, legal and ethical sides of the motion. Format: There will be an elimination round prior to the final and maximum eight participants would be chosen for the final round. The elimination round would consist of giving each participant a topic 15 minutes prior to their turn, and then 2 minutes to speak for/against the topic. There would be no rebuttals in the elimination round.
<b>Story Writing</b>	Number of Teams: <b>Open</b> Number of participant per team: <b>1</b> Time Allowed: <b>60 Minutes</b>  Get your pens ready, no computers for this 60 minute event. All you have to do is to write about the future as you see – build on our story. You will be provided with the opening or/and concluding paragraphs. The task of improvising the rest will be up to you. Anything and everything is allowed, you'll be free to write whatever you want as long as it does or does not make sense. Be Funny, be Weird but above all, be Insane!
<b>Gaming Zone</b>	Number of Team: <b>1</b> Number of participant per team: <b>1</b>  No need to explain this event. <i>Note that you must pre-register for this event before 19<sup>th</sup> December 2011 along with the entire school team.</i> There is an upper limit of participants for this event. Selection will be done on a first come first serve basis, provided all the necessary requirements are met. Some multi/single qualifying round will be played before the grand finale.

Participants will be provided with video clips, images and audio files related to the topic during the event. No external material will be allowed.</p>
